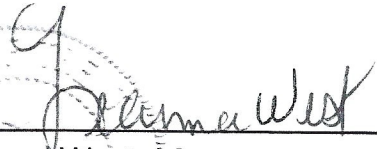


CITY OF TRENT
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CITY COUNCIL MEETING
CITY HALL 6:00 PM JUNE 11, 2026

Mayor Leanna West calls meeting to order with councilmen Geoff Goodnough, Orville Patterson, Peyton Valentine, and guests Thomas Rogers and James Meazell present. Minutes from last meeting were read. Geoff makes a motion to approve minutes as read, Orville seconds, motion carried. All was in favor. Oaths of office were read By Peyton Valentine and Geoff Goodnough. Thomas Rogers came speaking with the council about an interest in the downtown buildings. He will possibly be on next months agenda to discuss further interest in the buildings. Treasurers report was discussed. City bills were examined. 3 accounts remained off. Water loss was 35%. Leanna reported several complaints on strays around town. She has gotten permission to take the dogs to Clyde Animal Control if she can catch them. Community Center had 2 birthday parties and 1 reunion coming up. Geoff makes a motion to approve the consent agenda, Peyton seconds, motion carried. All was in favor. Leanna reported getting the ad in the American Classified for bids on the pickup and she is going to put an ad for the spool trailer also. Any sealed bids received by July 10 will be opened at July 14 meeting. City logo was discussed. Orville makes a motion to table, Peyton seconds, motion carried. All was in favor. Council discussed the boys dressing room in the old school gym. The owner of the RV park is interested in using it for showers and a laundry. Orville makes a motion to table pending further investigation, Geoff seconds, motion carried. All was in favor. Leanna gave an update on the Siren repair. Geoff makes a motion to purchase the lithium battery with a 10 year warranty for \$4,650.00, Peyton seconds, motion carried. All was in favor. Leanna had gotten some quotes on doing the annual audit. Peyton makes a motion to table while getting further information, Geoff seconds, motion carried. All was in favor. Waterline expansion was discussed. It is still in the works but information is being gathered. Geoff makes a motion to table, Orville seconds, motion carried. All was in favor. Resolution from Hibbs & Todd to file financial assistance for water system improvements was discussed. Geoff makes a motion to approve Resolution 332 to allow Hibbs & Todd to proceed to file for assistance, Peyton seconds,

motion carried. All was in favor. Next meeting was set for July 14, 2026. Meeting adjourned.
