

What We Know About the Proposed Project Near Trent

Purpose of This Document

The City of Trent is committed to providing factual, verified information regarding the proposed data center near our community.

This document summarizes information that has been confirmed by the City at the time of publication. It is intended to separate verified facts from information that has not yet been confirmed.

As additional verified information becomes available, this document will be updated.

What Has Been Confirmed?

Based on information currently available to the City:

- A data center has been proposed near Trent.
- The proposed project is located outside the corporate limits of the City of Trent.
- Because the project is outside the City limits, the City does not have the legal authority to approve, deny, or regulate the project.
- Representatives associated with the proposed project have met with City representatives to discuss the possibility of obtaining water service.
- Preliminary discussions have included the possible extension of a water line and a preliminary cost estimate based on information available at that time.
- No formal agreement for water service has been approved by the City Council.
- To the City's knowledge, construction has not begun.
- The City has not received final engineering plans describing the proposed project's long-term operational water requirements.

What Has Not Been Confirmed?

At this time, the City has **not** verified or confirmed the following information:

- The final site layout.
- The final number of buildings.
- A construction start date.
- A construction completion date.
- The number of permanent employees.
- The facility's long-term water requirements.
- The facility's electrical requirements.
- Any final construction schedule.
- Any future expansion plans.

Residents should be cautious when reading information from unofficial sources that present these items as confirmed facts.

What Is the City's Role?

The City's only potential involvement at this time relates to a possible request for water service.

If a formal request is submitted, it will be evaluated by the City Council through its normal public review process using verified engineering information, applicable laws, available system capacity, contractual requirements, and the City's responsibility to continue providing reliable water service to its existing customers.

How Will Residents Be Kept Informed?

The Community Information section of the City of Trent's official website is the official source for verified information regarding the proposed data center.

As additional information is confirmed, this document and other Community Information guides will be updated accordingly.

Residents are encouraged to visit the City's official website for the most current information and to avoid relying on rumors or speculation from unofficial sources.

The City's Commitment

The City of Trent is committed to providing residents with information that is accurate, factual, and based on verified information.

Rather than speculate about information that has not been confirmed, the City will continue updating this document as new facts become available.
